CONFESSION OF SINS

(Confession of sins sung according to CW 304, Jesus Sinners Does Receive)

- v1. Jesus sinners does receive; Oh, may all this saying ponder Who in sin's delusions live And from God and heaven wander. Here is hope for all who grieve—Jesus sinners does receive
- v2. We deserve but grief and shame, Yet his words, rich grace revealing, Pardon, peace, and life proclaim; Here their ills have perfect healing Who with humble hearts believe—Jesus sinners does receive.
 - v4. Come, O sinners, one and all, Come, accept his invitation.
 Come, obey his gracious call; Come and take his free salvation!
 Firmly in these words believe—Jesus sinners does receive
- **M**: Beloved in the Lord: let us draw near with a true heart and confess our sins to God our Father, asking him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness.
 - v5. I, a sinner, come to you With a penitent confession. Savior, show me mercy, too; Grant for all my sins remission. Let these words my soul relieve—Jesus sinners does receive.

ABSOLUTION

PSALM OF THE DAY: CW Psalm 111 (page 106 in the front part of the hymnal)


SECOND LESSON: Hebrews 9:24-28

²⁴ For Christ did not enter a sanctuary made with human hands that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence. ²⁵ Nor did he enter heaven to offer himself again and again, the way the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood that is not his own. ²⁶ Otherwise Christ would have had to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But he has appeared once for all at the culmination of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself. ²⁷ Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment, ²⁸ so Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him.

Alleluia. Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come. Alleluia. (Matthew 24:32, NIV)



After the announcement of the Gospel, the congregation sings:




³⁸As he taught, Jesus said, "Watch out for the teachers of the law. They like to walk around in flowing robes and be greeted with respect in the marketplaces, ³⁹and have the most important seats in the synagogues and the places of honor at banquets. ⁴⁰They devour widows' houses and for a show make lengthy prayers. These men will be punished most severely."

⁴¹Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury. Many rich people threw in large amounts. ⁴²But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents.

⁴³Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. ⁴⁴They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on."

CONFESSION OF FAITH—NICENE CREED






M: Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God.

The peace of the Lord be with you always.






DISTRIBUTION




